

2022 LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

ELIGIBILITY

1. The candidate must have been a Realtor[®] in good standing for the most recent (consecutive) 20 years, as well as a member with the Utah Central Association of Realtors[®] for the most recent 5 years.
2. The candidate must not have had a Code of Ethics violations at any point in the last 10 years. The committee will review candidates with violations occurring before the last 10 years.
3. The candidate must not have been personally sanctioned by the Division of Real Estate in the 5 years prior to receiving the recognition.
4. Throughout their career, the candidate has shared their time, talent, and expertise for the benefit of the entire profession.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Please attach a brief summary of why the individual should be considered for the award, no longer than 500 words. The summary should address the individual's history in real estate and how the individual has used their time, talent, and expertise for the benefit of the profession. Be sure to include the individual's full name and current brokerage.
2. Include three Realtor[®] references who will support this nomination. Please include name, brokerage, email, and phone number.

THE AWARD

1. One Lifetime Achievement Award will be given per year. However, the committee may choose to recognize any Realtor[®] who may have been eligible for the award but passed away during the award year. There is no limit to posthumous recognition.
2. The Awards Committee will review the applications and choose the award winner.
3. Application information will be audited by the awards committee.
